CAT 124: EXHIBTION BUILDING: THE EVENT AND EXPIERENCE

In collaboration with the Museum of Contemporary Art San Diego (MCASD), this practicum (CAT 124) will examine contemporary notions and visual practices around experience building as seen in MCASD's current exhibitions and programs. Exploring ideas around the Museum's relationship to the community, the buildings architecture and its relationship to artworks, the curation and installation of the exhibition, curriculum and educational programs, and strategies for institutional promotion.

Using the current MCASD exhibition the practicum will explore ideas around contemporary exhibition practices, public program development, and art making methods.

The seminar will take place over ten classes- five at MCASD, Downtown and five at UC San Diego. The final class will take the form as a culminating event at MCASD, Downtown. It will be led and organized collaboratively by MCASD and UC San Diego. Depending on availability MCASD curators and staff, and UC San Diego faculty will be invited to give brief talks.

This will be an intensive seminar- attendance of all classes will be required. Class locations may changed due to Museum schedules.

CONTACT HOURS EXPECTED

Students will be required to attend all practicum sessions. Each session will be 3 hours long. Students will be responsible for spend 10 hours outside of class each week continuing research, weekly readings, and completing assignments. ASSIGNMENTS/ GRADE BREAKDOWN

Over the course of the quarter students will collaboratively develop an event. Centering on experience making/ curation, curriculum development, promotion, exhibition design, and community outreach. Failure to complete any of the assignments will result in failing the course. Late assignments will result in 1/3 grade letter deduction (e.g. A to A-, A- to B+, etc.) for every 2 days past the due date.

All assignments and notes must be posted to the group Facebook page.

- **25% Event 1 Performance tour**: Develop a tour-styled experience around the UCSD MFA exhibition at MCASD. Perform it at MCASD on free third Thursday on April 27.
- **30% Event 2- Experience creation/ curation**: Create or curate an experience to contribute to the final event. Students will present their created or curated experiences twice in progress to the group for critique. A written proposal will be required. Proposals must include (project description, relation to MCASD exhibition, budget, development timeline, images and supplemental material)
- **15% Event design and installation**: Create a written proposal for the event (abstract, timeline, budget), host event
- **10% Press/ Outreach**: Create a proposal for the flier, postcard, and a distribution plan. Assist in distribution.
- **10% Weekly readings:** Select one of the pre-approved readings,. Read it and submit 4-6 essays for review. *Additional suggested readings may be submitted*. Each week 2 participants will lead discussions/workshops/talks/... around their readings
- **5% Attend events**: Attend 5 events over the course of the quarter at MCASD/UCSD/Cal-IT. After each event write a brief paragraph critiquing and reviewing it.

5% - Participation and attendance

Attendance: Any absences must be cleared with the TA in advance, or justified with written documentation (e.g. letter from student health, etc.). More than 3 unexcused absences from the seminar may result in failing the course.
