

Dear Sixth College Student Council Candidate,

Thank you for your interest in applying for a Sixth College Student Council elected position for the 2026-2027 academic year. The list of elected positions and job responsibilities can be found [here](#). The contents of this packet are vital to your candidacy; thus, I encourage you to review it very carefully, including the [Sixth College Election Bylaws](#). Please be sure to follow all steps in the process.

1. To validate your candidacy, you must first complete and submit the Candidate Intention/Eligibility form. Candidates for Associated Students Senator are also required to fill out the [Sixth College Candidate Intention/Eligibility Form](#). Completed Candidate Intention/Eligibility forms must be turned in by the end of the elections filing period, which is **NOON on Friday, March 13, 2026 (deadline extended)**. **Late or incomplete applications will forfeit your candidacy.**
2. Please complete your **Candidate Statement** online through [Associated Students](#) by **NOON on Friday, March 13, 2026**.
3. Additionally, you will need to attend a **mandatory** candidate's meeting that will take place **during Winter 2026 Finals Week (dates & times TBA)**. If you are unable to attend this meeting, you need to send a proxy. Proxy forms are available online through [Associated Students](#) and must be submitted in conjunction with your application. There may be only one proxy per candidate.
4. Please review the Sixth College Student Council [election bylaws](#), as you will be held responsible to them during the election process.

Once all Sixth College candidates are identified and confirmed to be eligible, they will be invited to submit individual information to be highlighted in an edition of Sixth News You Can Use. This candidate advertisement will need to be submitted no later than **Friday, March 20, 2025 at 11:59 PM**.

Any violation of these policies will be subject to sanctions, including disqualification of your individual or slate's candidacy. Please help to ensure that we have a fair and respectful campaign season.
