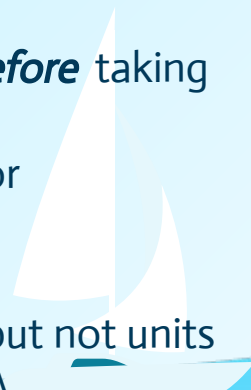

1. Community College Courses

Important notes for thinking about taking Community College courses:

- Regardless of course number, all CC courses are considered lower division
- Make sure courses are UC-transferable **before** taking the course
 - processing@ucsd.edu can be used for confirmation!
- 105 unit transfer limit →
 - Can still transfer courses for credit, but not units
 - CC GPA does not transfer to UC GPA





02. How to Know What Classes to Take:

Major/Minor Requirements

Ask your major department, with the potential to petition

GE Requirements

Meet with or talk to Sixth College (or other) about your GEs, with the potential to petition

University Requirements

Make sure courses have a direct approximation to meet these requirements.



Example: **Transfer Equivalencies | Department of Mathematics**

03. Tools for Planning Your Courses

ASSIST.ORG

The official, statewide online student-transfer information system in California. It acts as the central, most accurate repository of official articulation agreements



CVC.EDU

The CVC Exchange Instant Enrollment system enables students to easily find and register for fully accredited online classes offered by any participating community college throughout California.



04. What to Do After Taking the Course

Send Transcripts to UCSD Admissions

- Have transcripts sent to **UCSD Admissions** once your grades are finalized
 - Can take 8-10 weeks
 - Transcripts can be sent electronically or by mail
- Save Parchment ID number and date you sent the transcripts (if sending electronically)
